The Saint Andrew's Cup is an annual Ryder Cup-style golf tournament designed to promote fellowship and friendly competition between the Saint Andrew's Societies of Philadelphia and New York, created in 2014 in celebration of our shared heritage.

The Saint Andrew's Society of New York will host the Fourth Annual Saint Andrew's Cup on Wednesday, October 25th at Hamilton Farm Golf Club – a Hurdzan and Fry gem carved into the rolling hills of an historic equestrian estate, which now houses the United States Equestrian Team. The property also features the only USGA-rated par-3 course in the country.

THE FORMAT: Each Society shall field ten (10) players to compete in an individual match-play format. Official USGA handicaps will be used. Each match shall be worth one team point, awarded for an outright win; a draw results in a halved point. The winning side is the team that accumulates the most team points, with a draw seeing the reigning champ retain the trophy.

PLAYER SELECTION: All Society members fitting the following criteria, male and female, are invited to submit player applications.

Applicants must:

- Be in good standing with the Society (ie. current on dues)
- Have an official 18-hole USGA handicap index
- Be prepared to commit to the event if they are selected

Teams will be selected as follows:

SASNY shall assemble its team based on official USGA handicap and the classifications below. The team shall consist of the three best "A" players, the three best "B" players, the two best "C" players, and the two best "D" players.

Classifications:

"A" Player: (0-7 Handicap)

"C" Player: (16-21 Handicap)

"B" Player: (8-15 Handicap)

"D" Player: (22+ Handicap)

In the event there are not enough players to fill a certain classification, a spot may be filled by the best player in the next lower classification. However, spots may not be filled by a player in a higher classification. For example, a "B" player may fill an "A" spot, but an "A" player may not fill a lower classified spot.

A Players may fill A spots

B Players may fill B or A spots

C Players may fill C, B, or A spots

D Players may fill D, C, B, or A spots


Only in the event that lower-classified players are unavailable shall a player be permitted to fill a lower-classified spot on the roster.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS: Players will be encouraged to arrive at 8:00am for warm-up. Play will commence at 9:00am. Following play, both teams will be invited to the clubhouse for lunch, cocktails, and the presentation of the Cup. Food and beverage will be available for purchase.

EXPENSES: The fee for golf, including cart is \$190.00. Each foursome will have a forecaddie who should be tipped in cash at a suggested rate of \$50/bag. Each player will also be responsible for a minimum charitable contribution of \$100 towards the prize purse, which will benefit the winning society's Scholarship Fund and is deductible.

All applications must be returned by Friday, September 29th. The team will be announced the first week in October.
